- LCMC's ESL Classroom Program is unable to provide services to F-1 and J-1 visa holders.
- Registration and testing take a minimum of 3 hours to complete.
- If you arrive after registration has started, you will not be admitted.
- Space is limited. Students will be admitted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- You must be 18 years of age or older and live or work in Maryland.
- You can only register for one class per session.
- You will take a reading and listening test. Testing does not guarantee a class.
- Children are not allowed at testing or in class.
